The guards were DILFLE with awe.

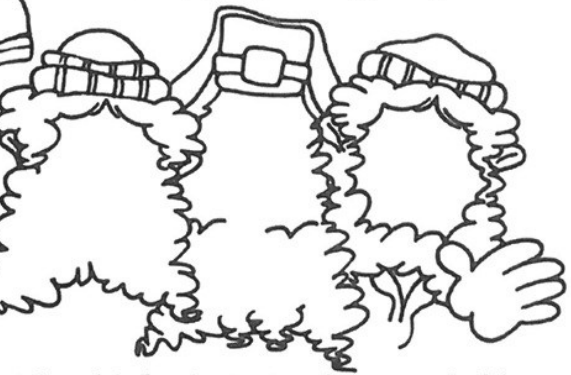

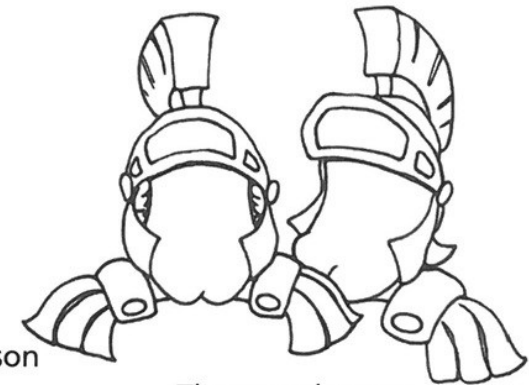
